EASA is seeking teens and young adults who have been involved with EASA to help improve and develop the support available at the local level and throughout the state. The group will prioritize and take action toward the things they feel are most important to change/improve. They will have direct access to local program administrators throughout the state and policy makers at the state level. It will be an opportunity to learn from the direct experience of participants as well as from feedback from others around the state, and to create positive change based on that feedback. Members are asked for a six-month commitment with the possibility of continuing after six months for those who remain interested. Members commit to monthly meetings (in person or by phone/video). There may also be some subcommittee work and other follow-up depending on what the group decides to pursue. A stipend and travel reimbursement as needed will be provided to support participation.
